The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a hand stitched English Leather headcollar to the young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) with the lowest overall score (irrespective of the class entered). If the driver with the lowest overall score is already in receipt of a Saddlers' prize in 2014, the headcollar for that event will be awarded to the next eligible driver not already in receipt of a Saddlers' prize. Multiple prizes will only be awarded if there are no eligible drivers not yet in receipt of a Saddlers' prize at that event.

Withdrawals: By 12 noon **Friday 20th June** to 01653 648847.

Stabling: Competitors are asked to report to the Stable Managers on arrival and to park where directed. Maximum 2 caravans per competitor will be permitted to park in the stabling area; any additional caravans will be required to park in an adjacent area at a cost of £10.00 per night. Paper bedding will NOT be permitted.

Electric fencing will be allowed but only in a designated area. The size of an uncovered pen is limited to 10ft x 10ft only one pen per competitor. The enclosure must be securely attached to a vehicle or trailer so as to prevent it being moved or dislodged by the horse or pony within. Competitors must advise the Stable Managers on arrival so that they can be parked accordingly. No horses/ponies may be tethered. Only horses/ponies entered for the event will be allowed on the showground.

No entry to Stabling Area before 0900 Wed 25th June (earlier by prior arrangement only)

All dogs are to be kept on leads at **ALL TIMES**

Matting is compulsory under bedding in portable stabling at all National events. A payment to cover the cost of restitution of the ground may be levied for non-compliance.

Catering: Licensed bar Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Hot snack bar during the day.

Veterinary: Vets will be on call on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday at competitors' own expense and on site Saturday and Sunday during the Marathon. All consumables must be paid for.

Marathon: The marathon course runs over tracks, parkland and farmland on Sandringham estate.

Location: Venue is situated off the A148 approx. 7 miles from Kings Lynn.

This year access will be via the West Newton gate (and not the cricket club gate).
