Prizes:	1 st - 6 th place in all classes. 1 st - 3 rd place in Dressage and Marathon (all classes). Best Cones rosette for each class. The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a hand stitched English Leather headcollar to the para-equestrian driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) with the lowest overall score (irrespective of the class entered). If the driver with the lowest overall score is already in receipt of a Saddlers' prize in 2018, the headcollar for that event will be awarded to the next eligible driver. Multiple prizes will not be awarded.

Marathon information:	Approx. 15km marathon on farm tracks, set-a-side, lanes woodlands and parkland. Mostly flat. 7 Obstacles in the front park with easy access for spectators and walking.
