Driven Dressage: Dressage tests for 2019 apply. 2 100m x 40m arenas. Pairs classes must specify their required dressage test at the time of entry.

Marathon: 3 sections. Section A approx. 5k over undulating woodland tracks and headlands. 1k transfer. Section B approx. 8.5k with 8 obstacles including water (6 for Novice classes and 7 for Intermediates).

Obstacle Cone Driving: Obstacle Fault Competition. 2 arenas.

Qualification: All drivers who have qualified will receive an invitation.

Entry conditions: The Championships are open to qualified competitors only.

Horses and ponies must be at least four years old.

All competitors must be International or Full members of British Carriagedriving, with the exception of Novices, who may compete with BC Associate membership, and competitors in the Evolution classes who may be Affiliated Club members.

All horses and ponies must be vaccinated in accordance with the prevailing BC rules.

Horse passports, to include record of vaccination, must be brought to the championships.

General Information:

Stabling There will be no stables available on site. There is a list of local yards that provide stabling for the Belsay Horse Trials available on request. Electric fence users will be accommodated in a separate area.

Caravans and additional vehicles: One caravan per competitor. Extra caravans are welcome at £20 for the duration of the event.

ATVs/Scooters: The obstacles are in close proximity to the box park. ATVs may be taken to the obstacles but note that access is across a public road.

Electric Hook-up: A limited number of electric hook ups will be available. Connection price to be confirmed. There will be no electric hook ups available in the electric fence area.

Catering: Catering information will be provided closer to date. There will be a drinks reception, party night and catering.

Location: From North, South and East - Bywell is located 12 miles from the A1. At Junction 75 take the A69 dual carriageway west bound, signed Hexham for 11 miles. Pass the B6309 junction then take the next left turn signed Bywell. Approach is downhill and there is NO slip road. From West – Take A69 eastbound towards Newcastle. Continue on A69 dual carriageway after Styford / Brockbushes roundabout for 1/2 mile. Turn right for Bywell. Post Code to follow is NE43 7TS. Just 1 mile to the event field. Narrow road but plenty of passing places.

A completed International Team Selection Form must be forwarded to the British Carriagedriving Office prior to the event or, at the very latest, be handed to a British Carriagedriving Council Member prior to you starting at your first selection event, i.e. this must be before you begin your Dressage Test! (Selection Forms can be downloaded from the web site or obtained from your Class Representative).

If the driver is under 18 years of age, the name of a responsible adult (over 18) who will be able to attend in case the driver's horse(s) are selected for drug testing, must be given on the entry form.
