<b>Withdrawals:</b>	By Saturday 4 September - Tel. 07856 404608
<b>Prizes:</b>	The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a training voucher to each para driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) who completes, without retiral or elimination, 3 National or Regional events in the current calendar year (the National Championships may count as one of the events). Multiple prizes will not be awarded. Applications for this award must be made to the BC office by 31st October 2021.
<b>Stabling:</b>	Please report to Stable Manager on arrival and park as requested. Mats NOT required. Electric fencing can be used, but note on your entry form.
<b>Additional vehicles:</b>	Permitted without charge.
<b>ATVs/Scooters:</b>	ATVs / scooters allowed subject to ground conditions.
<b>Dogs:</b>	Strictly on leads <b>AT ALL</b> times.
<b>Catering:</b>	Catering available on site from Friday noon until Sunday afternoon.
<b>Veterinary/Farrier:</b>	See event noticeboard.
<b>Marathon information:</b>	Approximately 12 km on parkland and tracks, with water crossings and a railway underpass; it's not a main line so don't panic. 7 obstacles sited in the parkland with undulating ground and small hills.
<b>Health &amp; Safety:</b>	Risk assessment posted on Notice Board. Health and Safety standards will be enforced. All persons on the Showground or Marathon course will be held responsible for complying with these standards at all times and will not put themselves or any other person at risk in any way whatsoever. Any accidents must be reported to the Safety Officer or the Event Secretary at the time of the occurrence. A report shall be entered into the Accident Report book and the relevant forms completed on-line via the BC website. All Government advice and protocols relating to Covid-19 must be followed.
<b>Location:</b>	Frickley Hall, Frickley Estate, Doncaster, South Yorkshire, DN5 7BU <b>Please do not allow your sat nav to take you through Barnsley itself. Try to approach the event from the A1 only.</b> Unless you live locally, it is strongly recommended that all visitors approach the event off the A1. Please leave the A1 at the A638 exit. The event will be well signed posted after exiting from the A1 (it will not be signposted on the A1 itself). Proceed through the village of Hooton Pagnell, turning down the hill in the village towards Clayton. The entrance to the estate is located on your right hand side approximately 500 yards after leaving Hooton Pagnell, just as the road bends to the left. Proceed along the main estate drive and under the disused railway arch (please use the passing places provided). A one way system is in operation. All parking is on the right near the Hall.
